

Teshuva - Repent

***“Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto YHVH, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our Elohim, for he will abundantly pardon.*”**

[Isa 55:7]

The word ***teshuva*** means “return/turnaround”. If a person violates one of YHVH’s commandments (mitzvos), he is required to "return" to YHVH.

Teshuva consists of three basic steps:

1. Admitting your sin to YHVH. This is a private matter.
2. Feeling regret that you have sinned.
3. Making a commitment not to repeat the sin.

***If we confess our sins, HE is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.*”**

[I John 1:9]

YHVH Will Not Be Mocked

***For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins,*”**

[Hebrews 10:26]

So what do I do? Confess your sin and return to YHVH by following HIS commandments.

My Burden is Light

***“For my yoke [is] easy, and my burden is light.”*”**

[Mat 11:30]

YeShua said “For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.”
